PRIMARY RECEPTION APPLICATIONS 2026-2027

For all children born from **1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022** inclusive, their parents/carers will need to apply for a reception class place. National closing date for on time reception applications **15 January 2026.**

Even if your child has a sibling that attends your preferred school, you will still need to make an <u>e-admissions</u> application.

Before submitting a reception application we strongly recommend all families read the <u>Primary School Prospectus 2026</u> edition of the local authorities 'Starting Primary School' guide and find out information about the school you are interested in.

BOOK OF THE MONTH


Book of the month link: *Hair Love* for parents

REBECCA CHEETHAM TO BECOME A SAFER STREETS SCHOOL

Healthy School Streets are roads that have timed access restrictions for most motor vehicles at school start and finish times. This makes it safer and easier for children and their families to walk, cycle or scoot to school. Due to the abundance of traffic that enters our cul-de-sac and the vulnerable age of our children, the Local Authority have identified our school as one of their newest Safer Steets. Once we have complete details, we will chare them with you, but the new times restrictions will come into effect from January. We'd also like to remind everyone to be mindful when moving around the outside area. There are often small children walking about, and it's easy to accidentally bump into them. Taking a little extra care as we move around will help keep all our children safe and protected.
