Working Together

Working Together is the name of Newham's Early Years Hub, funded by the Greater London Authority to improve children's life chances in London.

Working Together is led by Newham's Nursery Schools, in partnership with the Best Start in Life team. We work with private and voluntary sector settings, childminders, schools, and our training provider Protrain.

We are:

- Improving the quality and inclusion of early education in Newham so that we make a positive difference to all children's life chances;
- Increasing the quality and supply of the early years workforce in line with the creation of new places;
- Ensuring that at least 75% of disadvantaged two year olds in Newham access a free early education place, so that the most vulnerable children won't be left behind in future.

We offer:

- A free Professional Development programme for Newham practitioners;
- A mentor with expertise in early education and care, who will support your setting with termly self-assessment and action planning visits;
- Half-termly local network development meetings for settings in each quadrant;
- Free pre-employment training for those who want to work in early years education, including functional skills (Maths and English) courses, confidence and self-esteem building, Level 2 for 19-23 year olds and Teaching Assistant qualifications
