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Page 3 How we spent out Inset Day

We spent a wonderful training day on Friday 23rd November learning some amazing techniques in Special Yoga; a programme celebrating mindfulness for mental and emotional health resilience in the early years. We took part in a range of exercises in order to develop mindful practice within ourselves and then how to introduce such techniques to the children in order to develop a sense of peace, calm and self-regulation.

"Emotional, Sensory and Behavioural self-regulation grows and strengthens over time for young children. This is hugely due to nurturing attachment relationships and through adults around them living and modelling ways o integrate the brain, the emotions and the different systems of the body.

A child's awareness of how to recognise and label how they are feeling, together with a growing process of how to contain and regulate their emotions plays a fundamental part in their relationships with themselves, other people and the world around them."







We eventually hope to offer parents some workshops in order to teach you some of these techniques to help restore calm in your own lives.
