Dear all,

We have been notified today that there has been a confirmed positive PCR COVID-19 case in the nursery.

We are following government guidance in regards to this and the current guidance is to continue to send your child in to nursery. <u>Government guidance is advising that children who come into contact with positive cases do not need to isolate.</u>

We are maintaining protective measures such as testing, ventilation and extra hygiene precautions to help keep children and staff safe and minimise disruption to face-to-face education. Much of the children's day is spent outside in the garden where infection transmission is so much lower.

Do send your child to school, unless one of the following applies:

- your child is unwell, which includes displaying symptoms of Covid-19
- your child has a positive diagnosis of Covid-19 following a lateral flow test or PCR test, your child should stay and home and for at least 10 days.

If you have concerns about your child attending school, please don't hesitate to discuss your concerns with a member of staff.

We recommend that:

- You carry on with COVID safe measures when out and on the way to and from school.
- Book a PCR test at any of Newham's walk-up sites (call 119 or https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirustest) if your child or anyone in your house has symptoms of:
 - a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
 - a new, continuous cough
 - a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
