We are delighted to announce that our school has been awarded the Inclusive Quality Mark Flagshipfor the second time.





We use books to open up a world of learning for our children. The core books we use relate to children's interests and we feed that through the breadth of activities we offer within the provision. This month our key book is **Jabari Jumps**, written and illustrated by Gaia Cornwall. Jabari Jumps is fantastic book that helps us to be brave and look at how we can tackle those things that make us scared or nervous. We find how important it is to have that wonderful adult encouragement there to help us along.

# **READING LIBRARY**

Welcome to Rebecca Cheetham's Reading Library.

Hello, my name is Empress and I work in the front reception.

At Rebecca Cheetham, we have started a reading library. The reason for starting this initiative is so to develop a love of books and reading in all children. This is at the heart of all we do here at nursery. We love to encourage all members of the family to read to and with the children to foster this passion. There are a wide range of books to choose from including bilingual books.

When your child joins the reading library, they will be given a reading passport which is used to collect stamps for each book they <u>read and return</u>. Children will be allowed to borrow **ONE** book, **ONCE** a week to read and enjoy.

Once your child has been awarded 6 stamps, they will receive a personalised bookmark in recognition of their achievement. When they have collected all 12 stamps, they will receive a certificate and have their name mentioned in the newsletter.

The reading library runs on <u>Tuesdays 8am – 3:45pm, Wednesdays 10am</u> <u>6pm</u> and <u>Thursdays 8am – 3:45pm</u>.

We ask if you could keep reading library books separate from other books that are given home in book bags to avoid confusion.
