What do Governors do?

Governors work in partnership with the Headteacher of the school to manage the school. Their duties include:

- agreeing the school improvement plan;
- deciding how the school budget will be set;
- setting aims for the curriculum (what is taught);
- recruiting senior staff;
- agreeing school policies, e.g. on equal opportunities, health & safety; etc. and
- providing information to parents.

What commitment is needed?

Governors attend one or more full governing body meetings per term, plus committee meetings and visits to the school. Governing body meetings are mostly held in the evening. The term of office for individual governors is between 1 to 4 years.
